Responsibilities

Leadership

- Primary worship leader for all our gatherings both In-person and Online. This includes, sunday, retreats, monthly and weekly events.
- Pursue growth through having a teachable spirit.
- Work in collaboration with other ministries to develop a worship culture in all our gathering spaces.
- Develop other leaders

Volunteer Development

- Recruit volunteers and oversee the onboarding process. Interviews, auditions and coaching.
- Build multiple teams to be on rotation. Raise other leaders who can lead at your level.
- Coordinate and lead regular music team gatherings to disciple, cast vision and build relationships.
- Care and develop. Regular check ins with the volunteers

Administration

- Resource and support all volunteers.
- Schedule all volunteers and other ministry partners in advance to ensure we have appropriately rostered gatherings of worship.
- Work in collaboration with the Services producer and the Pastoral team to create a cohesive transcendent worship experience.
- Give input to the creation of the worship environment.
- Refine and develop systems and processes of planning and growing of the ministry.
- Accountable for technical development of the team.
- Organize weekly rehearsals.
